# XICKSTART SCHEME

## Collaborative offer to support employers delivered by:







The colleges will provide a cohesive offer which includes an employability support package of online training (6 x pre-recorded sessions) covering the below topics which the young person will be able to access online during their placement.

### **Employability Support Package for Kickstart**

£75 per session or £400 for all 6 sessions

- Developing and writing your CV
- Looking for long-term work and completing an application online
- Interview preparation and skills
- Personal targets and future goal setting
- Organisation skills, time management and attendance
- Communication skills and teamwork

Package includes access to at least 3 worksheets for each unit for the young person to work through and share with their employer.

## Additional Mentoring Support and Certification £350

- 3 x 1-1 mentoring calls during placement
- Mentor to discuss session worksheets with young person and provide feedback
- Certificate provided on confirmation by mentor of successful completion of online training and associated worksheets

#### Possible extension offers:

As well as the above core training offer, some colleges may be able to offer additional courses and qualifications to support young people such as First Aid, Food Hygiene, Customer Service, Digital Skills and English and maths.
